FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISION IN VAUGHAN

The York Regional Police Collision Reconstruction Unit is investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred on Friday, October 7, 2005, in the City of Vaughan.

At approximately 6:40 a.m., a blue 1994 Chevrolet Suburban was traveling southbound on Dufferin Street approaching Langstaff Road. The truck made a right hand turn at the intersection, striking a cyclist. The cyclist, Vladimir **KUKOLEV**, 58 years, of Richmond Hill, sustained life-threatening injuries.

For unknown reasons, the Chevrolet Suburban continued westbound on Langstaff Road with the bicycle wedged under the front end. The truck stopped approximately one kilometre west of the collision scene.

The cyclist was rushed to hospital and despite the best efforts of emergency services, succumbed to his injuries.

Rick **WARZONEK**, 58 years, of Newmarket, was charged with Failing to Remain at the Scene of an Accident. Mr. WARZONEK is scheduled to appear before the Ontario Court of Justice in Newmarket on November 14, 2005.
